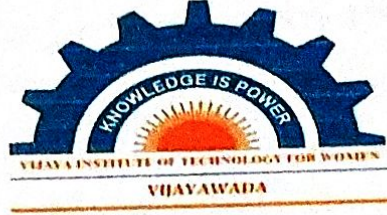

Whereas:

Mission:

To Impart Value based Scientific Knowledge through Quality Technical Education. The promoter "BAPATLA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY" has a vast experience of nearly six decades in running different educational institutions.

Objectives of MoU:

1. To promote & enhance academic interest between VITW and BWEC.
2. To provide advice for implementation of quality of education between VITW and BWEC.
3. To promote research/continuing education activities between parties.
4. Technical support in projects related to science and management from senior faculty or experts.
5. To refer or depute faculty or Resource persons for specific programs as speakers.

Technical areas of collaboration:

- A. A continuing quality improvement programme to improve quality of teaching staff in both parties.
- B. Providing academic interaction by delivering special lectures at both institutes on topics of relevance to modern industry.
- C. Provide necessary helps in organizing workshops, conferences and personality development programmes at both parties for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- D. Provides necessary support for establishment of wifi assistance for online courses for students and their Labs, Curriculum, Establishment of research labs, training and placement, library etc. at both parties.
- E. To provide training programmes for Students & Staff.

Terms & conditions:

1. The cost of development of infrastructure at both parties should be borne by themselves.
2. For continuing education to teachers and students the financial arrangements will be made mutually agreed terms.
3. For the visits related to advice & consultancy, travel and other expenses of faculty & staff shall be reimbursed by both the parties on mutually agreed terms.
4. The faculty and students of both parties can use library facilities for a short time.
5. Both parties agreed to help identify and invite the faculty members & researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
6. This MoU may be amended, removed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.
7. Either party should have the right to terminate this MoU upon 60days prior written notice to the other Party.

A. Confidentiality:

The VITW and BWEC agreed to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained from either party or created during the performance of MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party.

The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data processed by either party before entering into this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

B. Coordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

C. Tenure and Termination

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for one year, and may be continued there after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. However, VITW and BWEC will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

D. Arbitration Clause





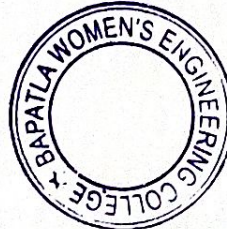

This MoU is entered into on the day of 22nd OCTOBER 2021 between AMRITA SAI INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, PARITALA (hereinafter called ASIST), and BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, BAPATLA (hereinafter called BWEC). AMRITA SAI INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY was established in 2007 offering various undergraduate and postgraduate programs in engineering disciplines with state-of-the-art infrastructure and facilities. ASIST College was ISO Certified Institution in the year 2010 and the institution became Autonomous campus in the year 2018. In the interest of establishing a relationship of mutual benefit to both organizations, AMRITA SAI INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, PARITALA (ASIST) and BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, BAPATLA (BWEC) have agreed to the areas of collaboration on academic and research related activities as mentioned in this MoU.

1. Objectives:

1.1. To contribute further to the regional understanding between faculty and staff of ASIST and BWEC for enhancing skills of students/aspirants through internship and vocational training in order to enhance the quality of Technical and Engineering education in the Country.

1.2. To strengthen collaboration between ASIST and BWEC through academic programs in instruction, research and faculty development among the faculty and students of both parties.

2. Scope

The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

1. Developing research projects jointly and avail funding
2. Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities
3. Students Exchange

4. Faculty and Staff Exchange
5. Research aid to Ph.D. scholars by both parties
6. Intellectual property rights of the collaboration work belonging to both parties
7. Organizing/participation in Joint symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops etc.
8. Developing articulations for twinning/joint programs and allowing students to undertake part of the programme/course of study at each organization; and
9. Promoting such other activities/programs as mutually agreed from time to time.

2.1 Developing research projects jointly and avail funding

Both the parties agree to undertake research projects/activities through sharing of research ideas, data and academic resources that can lead to joint publications, development of any product or other intended outcomes like Intellectual property rights/patents/discoveries generated out of the research activities, belonging to both parties. Such collaboration activities will also include joint research conferences, visitations and sabbaticals at each other's premises; subject to mutual consent of both the parties. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms and conditions lay down by separate written agreement by both organizations.

2.2 Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities

Both parties agree to exchange academic information, facilities, resources etc. as mutually agreed from time to time.

2.3 Students Exchange

Short Term Courses: These courses, usually two to four weeks in duration, will normally be held in spring or summer as mutually agreed. The programs will facilitate visits by students and faculty to learn about the industry environment and culture. In addition to various topics on industry operations and culture, the course would include meetings with industry executives, and visits to various industrial establishments. The cost and other terms of such programs will be mutually worked out separately each year.

2.4 Faculty and Staff Exchange

Both organizations agree to develop opportunities for faculty to teach courses, conduct seminars and undertake such other activities at each other's campus as mutually agreed. Visiting faculty will be provided with opportunities to observe and share

teaching methods and curriculum. ASIST and BWEC will exchange faculty according to the terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon.

2.5 Organizing/ participation in seminars, conferences, workshops etc.

Both organizations will promote their faculty and staff participation in the conferences, conclaves and seminars organized by each other to strengthen the ties between both the organizations and will also jointly organize seminars, conferences, workshops and other programs as mutually agreed.

3. Advertising & Publicity

Both the parties will publicly advertise the collaboration under this MoU among students, staff etc., if agreed by their management. Where reasonably possible, in making advertisements or public announcements in relation to this MoU, each organization shall acknowledge the participation of other organization and the contribution that other organization has made if any.

4. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment




This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the both organizations and will remain in effect for THREE (3) years. This MOU will be renewed upon its expiry, as per mutual agreement of both organizations. If either organization wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of one year period or in between the period of one year, it must notify the other organization not less than one month prior to the expiry of the MOU. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host party already initiated or ongoing unless otherwise mutually agreed. This MoU, its renewal and the actions taken under it will be reviewed at any time. Modifications to MoU will be made by mutual consent and any amendment or extension to the MoU will be formalized by the exchange of letters and or emails between the two organizations.

5. Coordinators:

Each organization agrees to appoint an overall Coordinator for the administration of this MOU. The Coordinator will serve as the contact person on campus. These coordinators will ensure smooth flow of communication and would be responsible to ensure that necessary approvals are in place for student/faculty exchange, articulation agreement etc. These coordinators will be responsible to ensure the effectiveness and enforcement MOU. Both organizations are responsible for keeping their contact details up to date. Contact details and address of the designated coordinators are given here under.

6. Resolution of Disputes and Governing Law

In the event of any unforeseen issues or matters not covered herein or any controversy, dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this MoU, the same shall be resolved amicably by both the organizations. This MoU and further agreements will in all respect be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of India. This MOU shall be signed in counterpart. Each counterpart will constitute an original document and these counterparts taken together, shall constitute one and the same MOU.

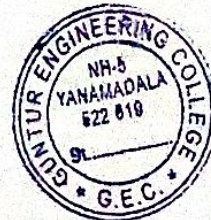

- iii **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, ANDHRA PRADESH** intends to procure training and experiential learning services provided by HET on the terms agreed to herein, in order to stimulate and facilitate the development of programmes/modules which serve to enhance educational, social, spiritual & emotional development of students. Further, HET and CLPT in support of their interest in the field of education are desirous of promoting mutual cooperation by organizing and conducting educational workshops for mental, spiritual and psychological well-being of its students, and desire to extend the basis for friendly and cooperative collaboration by way of this MOU.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS UNDER:

1 PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

1.1 **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** desires to create a precedent by offering suitable and pertinent learning and offerings to its students so as to enable them to lead their lives with purpose and be of help to the society at large. **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** has represented that it is a leading college that offers high quality education and its priority is to provide its students values, inner development enabling them to perform better in their education & be leaders in nation building. It seeks to provide its students basic life skills to manage challenges in their relationships, avoid intoxicating abuses, digital dependence and deal with stress of

modern life. It aims to enable their students and staff to de-stress, manage life's challenges in healthy ways and find joy, purpose and fulfilment. This will directly enhance their academic and work performance and create a harmonious environment within **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh**.

- 1.2 HET has agreed to be helpful in such mission through its offerings as listed out in Schedule 1 ("**Offerings**"). [HET may also conduct a thorough teacher and administrative staff training program in Heartfulness approach for their inner development so as to enable them to encourage students in this program].
- 1.3 Both the Parties, hereby express their commitment to collaborate with each other to conduct (i) educational, (ii) Heartfulness relaxation, meditation and (iii) other connected wellness workshops to help students teachers to regulate their minds, moderate their tendencies, increase their concentration, sharpen the use of their will, introspect and self-analyse and accept people and situations in general. Through such workshops and Offerings of HET, they intend to help the students to improve their learning skills and behaviour, and inculcate humility, emotional maturity, confidence, stress management, self-awareness and most importantly, develop a sense of purpose towards life.

2 FACILITATORS

Both Parties shall nominate one or more representatives, who shall be the point of contact/ facilitator ("**Facilitators**") for the purposes of this MOU. The Facilitators of the respective Parties shall maintain regular contact with each other. Further, they shall propose and review the response received from the participants for the workshops and other activities that may be conducted pursuant to this MOU and in furtherance to fulfilling the purpose and objectives envisioned under this MOU.

3 RESOURCES

- 3.1 **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** shall make arrangements at its agreed venue(s) with required reference and reading material as specified by HET, by establishing a (i) heartfulness corner in their library, and (ii) meditation practice room, and by providing such audio-visual equipment and other facilities as shall be

required for conduct of the workshops and/or programmes with respect to the Offerings.

3.2 **HET** shall nominate such teachers, trainers and support staff as it deems necessary for conducting and providing training to participants at these workshops and programs pursuant to this MOU.

3.3 **HET** shall provide support to orient National Institute of Technology Andhra Pradesh's teachers to conduct the sessions as advised by **HET** for the students at **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** and shall provide such external support as required. Through these Offerings **HET** will make students at **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** understand values and their role in improving the quality of their life and enable them to impart spiritual training as an extended activity in its institutions as and when feasible.

3.4 The Parties agree to distribute reading materials/ promotional/ literature to the participants, through any means including but not limited to audio and/or video recordings, books and magazines as deemed fit by **HET**. **HET** shall share the content of such reading materials, literature, video recordings and other such material with **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh**, before distributing the same to the participants.

3.5 The Parties further agree that at **HET's** discretion, they shall set up stalls at the program venue to distribute promotional items including but not limited to clothing, apparel, mementoes, brochures, other merchandise and/or articles and details of the programme etc.

3.6 The Offerings detailed in Schedule 1 shall be the scope of service to be rendered by **HET** which will be adhered to by **HET** during the term of this MOU.

4 OTHER OBLIGATIONS OF BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, ANDHRA PRADESH

4.1 **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** shall extensively promote **HET** Offerings so that greater populace of students in National Institute of Technology Andhra Pradesh shall benefit from this initiative. As previously indicated in Clause 1.1 above, being a

value-based model of education, **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** may make all or any part of the Offerings, as applicable, a part of their curriculum for the students on a mutually agreed basis between the Parties.

4.2 BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh
shall:

4.2.i Take initiatives such that its students shall attend the sessions conducted by **HET** with an objective to help them develop ideal value systems within to make them global citizens;

4.2.ii Facilitate students to integrate and imbibe such values into their lives and education;

4.2.iii Jointly conduct surveys at regular intervals to find the effectiveness of the programs conducted pursuant to this MOU;

4.2.iv Encourage its students, faculty, staff and administration to share written, audio and/or video testimonials with respect to any training programs, workshops or seminars conducted by **HET**;

5 FINANCIAL UNDERSTANDING

5.1 **HET** shall provide its services with respect to Heartfulness meditation practices on a free of charge basis at all times as agreed. However, it is hereby agreed that certain expenses relating to but not limited to training programs, workshops and faculty shall be on a charged basis in the following manner. **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE Andhra Pradesh** shall bear the expenses:

5.1.i Relating to the Offerings in terms of material, recommended readings, library heartfulness corner, meditation room(s) to be used by students and teachers at **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE Andhra Pradesh** shall be borne by **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE Andhra Pradesh** and the same would be set up as per the recommendations made by **HET**.

5.1.ii For training programs for faculty and students organised at **HET** centres, wherein an appropriate per diem expense would be undertaken by **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** for boarding and lodging of the participants.

5.2 Logistic:

BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh shall reimburse all expenses with respect to (i) all actual to and from travel expenses, including but not limited to train, bus, flight and taxi, borne by all the HET trainers and special guests who are invited to **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting sessions/programs, (ii) food and (iii) other miscellaneous expense shall be reimbursed. BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE Andhra Pradesh shall provide accommodation facilities to such trainers and special guests. HET shall provide such guidelines as necessary.

6 TERM

- 6.1 This MOU has been executed for the purpose of organizing workshops/ seminars/ training sessions at the premises of **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** or such other premises as may be mutually agreed upon in writing.
- 6.2 This MOU shall come into effect from the Execution Date and shall remain in force for a period of one year thereafter.
- 6.3 This MOU shall terminate after completion of the term of one year from the Execution Date, without any financial obligations of Parties, except for any pending reimbursements and costs as provided herein.
- 6.4 The Parties may execute similar agreements for similar initiatives in future or even extend the term of this MOU for such further periods as mutually agreed to by the Parties.
- 6.5 Either Party may voluntarily terminate this MOU by giving a 3 months' notice in writing to the other.
- 6.6 The provisions of this Clause 6.6 and 8 and all of its sub-clauses will survive any expiration or termination of this MOU.

7 ASSIGNMENT

This MOU is personal to the Parties and the rights and obligations established herein shall not be assignable by the Parties, except to the extent expressly permitted under this MOU or with the prior written consent of the other Party.

8 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 8.1 Neither Party shall exercise any rights in the trademarks, copyright or other intellectual property of the other Party, except as expressly stipulated herein.
- 8.2 All intellectual property rights including all (i) copyrights and other rights associated with works of authorship throughout the world, including neighboring rights, moral rights, and mask works, (ii) trade secrets and other confidential information, (iii) patents, patent disclosures and all rights in inventions (whether patentable or not), (iv) trademarks, trade names, internet domain names, and registrations and applications for the registration thereof together with all of the goodwill associated therewith, (v) all other intellectual and industrial property rights of every kind and nature throughout the world and however designated, whether arising by operation of law, contract, license, or otherwise, and (vi) all registrations, applications, renewals, extensions, continuations, divisions, or reissues thereof now or hereafter in effect ("**IPR**") with respect to (a) "Heartfulness", (b) "Heartfulness Relaxation", (c) "Heartfulness Meditation", (d) "Heartfulness Cleaning", their techniques and/or connected procedures therein and (d) the title and content/modules or any other information shared with BAPATLA ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh, it's staff, students and teachers, as the case may be, as part of the Offerings of HET, and (e) other trademarks belonging to **HET** or of those of its associates, (collectively referred to as "**Heartfulness IP**") as and when used by **HET** under license shall always vest with **HET** or its associates, as applicable. **HET** reserves the right to use the same internally or externally at its sole discretion.
- 8.3 This MOU in no way creates or conveys any ownership interests in Heartfulness IP to **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh**. BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh shall only use such Heartfulness IP or any part thereof, in the manner and form previously approved in writing by **HET** and in coordination with and assistance of **HET** authorized representatives.
- 8.4 HET reserves the right to modify, change or improve such Heartfulness IP in the manner it deems fit and implement such changed versions of Heartfulness IP or wellness techniques at anytime during the term of this MOU.
- 8.5 The Parties agrees that all ownership rights in any and all testimonials submitted in accordance with Clause 4.2 (iv) above shall vest with **HET**.

9 INDEMNITY

- 9.1 Except for cost reimbursements, the services provided by **HET's** with respect to the Offerings are on a mutual basis and free of cost. Only willing participants for their own wellbeing / self-development are required to participate. **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** may for development of its students make the **HET** programs, modules and/or workshops as part of its curriculum. The Parties, therefore, agree that such services do not give rise to any kind of damage or liability to anybody who participates and therefore no damage can arise there from. No indemnity is therefore provided herein. The Parties agree that that **HET** programs do not guarantee success of its objectives or purposes as mentioned anywhere in this MOU.
- 9.2 In the event **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** breaches the terms of Clause 8 (intellectual property) of this MOU, **HET** shall be entitled to seek specific performance against the **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** for performance of its obligations under Clause 8 (intellectual property) of this MOU in addition to any and all other legal or equitable remedies available to it.

10 GOVERNING LAW, JURISDICTION & ARBITRATION

- 10.1 This MOU shall be construed, interpreted and enforced in accordance with laws of India. In case of any differences between the Parties, they shall make all efforts to settle the disputes amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation within [• days], failing which, dispute(s) shall be referred to a sole arbitrator appointed by both the Parties, as per provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Language of arbitration shall be English and place of arbitration shall be [Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh].
- 10.2. Subject to the arbitration Clause 10.1 above, the courts of competent jurisdiction at [Vijayawada] shall have exclusive jurisdiction with respect to any and all matters pertaining to this MOU.

11 MISCELLANEOUS

- i This MOU together with any other documents including but not limited to memorandum of understandings, communications exchanged between the Parties defining responsibilities, obligations of both the Parties for different programs, initiatives etc. under this MOU, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which, taken together, shall constitute an integral part of this MOU constitute the entire agreement and supersedes any previous agreement between the Parties relating to the subject matter of this MOU.



It is on principle to principle basis.





SCHEDULE-1
Scope of Work

Heartfulness Education Trust (HET) shall offer the following programs specifically developed for specific needs of the University:

- vii.1 **Staff Training:** HET shall impart a training program on "Wellness at work" to all Principals, Teachers and Staff of the **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** institutions at its campus. **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** may at its sole discretion make it compulsory for their faculty/staff. Initially, this would be a three-day program to introduce the Heartfulness Meditation Practice and how it can be integrated into best education practices. This wellness program can also be offered at Kanha Shanti Vanam, the world headquarters of Heartfulness located near chegur village, RangaReddy district with a residential programme facility on mutually agreed basis.
- vii.2 **In-depth Faculty Training on Heartfulness Curricula:** Following initial introduction, interested faculty would be provided a longer duration in-depth teacher training program to further enhance and develop the Heartfulness tools and Curricula. This program would be developed suitably by Heartfulness Education Trust and made available at Kanha Shanti Vanam / Heartfulness centres or on **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** campus on an ongoing basis on agreed intervals during the term of this MOU.
- vii.3 **HELM (Heartfulness Enabled Leadership Mastery) curriculum for students:** HET shall choose a college on **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** campus to begin an in-depth training for students. This would cover a [3 day] induction program and a [16-week] life-skills course which will be followed by subsequent foundational leadership programs such as 'Discover', 'Develop', 'Deepen', 'Dedicate' etc which can be included as credit courses. These are core Heartfulness programs conducted by certified Heartfulness trainers which will be experiential sessions of 60-90 minutes for each student group.
- vii.4 **Internships for students:** Faculty offering 'Heartful Electives' can design projects that aim to integrate ethical and contemplative aspects into particular student projects.
- vii.5 **Leadership Conclave/Roundtable on Heartfulness Leaderships:** HET shall conduct a 3-day workshop for the senior management of **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh**, including to limited to the vice-chancellors, registrars of **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** to

shine some light on the relationship between meditation and education.

- vii.6 **H.E.A.R.T:** **HET** shall conduct a workshop for the faculty at BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE Andhra Pradesh, to inspire them to teach in a reflective manner and also to help them integrate meditative aspects to their course design.
- vii.7 **Heartfulness Meditation Workshop:** **HET** shall introduce the experience of Heartfulness Meditation to the administration department, the ground staff, general public and parents of the students at **BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE, Andhra Pradesh** through a 3-day experiential workshop.
- vii.8 **Inner Well Being Workshop:** **HET** shall introduce the experience of Heartfulness Meditation to counsellors and/or peer counsellors and provide them with techniques to help students handle situation in a calmer manner, through a 3-day workshop.

**A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON "ACADEMIC
COLLABORATION"**

BETWEEN

BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE

BAPATLA, Guntur, A.P.

This MoU is entered into on the day of **29th JUNE, 2021** between NRI Institute of Technology (Autonomous) situated at Pothavarappadu, Vijayawada an Engineering college (hereinafter called NRI) affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Kakinada and BAPATLA WOMEN'S ENGINEERING COLLEGE (hereinafter called BWEC), affiliated to Acharya Nagarjuna University, Guntur. The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes. Sri Durga Malleswara Educational Society was established in 2007 with the objective of reaching the zenith in the field of education. NRI College of Pharmacy, started in 2007 and NRI Institute of Technology, started in 2008 are the result of such sincere and dedicated efforts and stern determination of the founders of the society. NRI Institute of Technology is an AICTE approved Institution affiliated to the JNTUK which functions as a private self-financing institution to cater to the needs of juvenile aspirants in and around Vijayawada. The promoters of NRIIT started the college with a vision to empower the students with vibrant technology, sensitively matured and innovative to face the challenges of real time global experiences. The founders are socially conscious and continuously responding to the needs and requirements of the region, to uplift the region and to promote educational facilities by establishing schools, to promote games and sports activities in the region, help the poor and improve their health standards by organizing free medical camps etc., Since the day of inception, NRIIT has been growing at a credible but steady pace for an educational institution of its kind. Both NRIIT and NRI College of Pharmacy have been taking a place of pride every year JNTUK results are announced. NRI College of Pharmacy had recently added a feather to the crown of the Society by successfully placing its first outgoing batch of dynamic young pharmacists in various esteemed Organizations is an Autonomous

Institution with good discipline as well as Result oriented with NAAC-A Grade, JNTU Kakinada -Permanent affiliation and ISO Certified Institution. In the interest of establishing a relationship of mutual benefit to both organizations, NRI Institute of Technology, Vijayawada (NRIIT) and (BWEC) have agreed to the areas of collaboration on academic and research related activities as mentioned in this MoU.

1. Objectives:

- 1.1. To contribute further to the regional understanding between faculty and staff of NRIIT and BWEC for enhancing skills of students/aspirants through internship and vocational training in order to enhance the quality of Technical and Engineering education in the Country.
- 1.2. To strengthen collaboration between NRIIT and BWEC through academic programs in instruction, research and faculty development among the faculty and students of both parties.

2. Scope

The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of

Understanding includes the following categories:

1. Developing research projects jointly and avail funding
2. Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities
3. Students Exchange
4. Faculty and Staff Exchange
5. Research aid to Ph.D. scholars by both parties
6. Intellectual property rights of the collaboration work belonging to both parties
7. Organizing/participation in Joint symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops etc.
8. Developing articulations for twinning/joint programs and allowing students to undertake part of the programme/course of study at each organization; and
9. Promoting such other activities/programs as mutually agreed from time to time.

2.1 Developing research projects jointly and avail funding

Both the parties agree to undertake research projects/activities through sharing of research ideas, data and academic resources that can lead to joint publications,

development of any product or other intended outcomes like Intellectual property rights/ patents/discoveries generated out of the research activities, belonging to both parties. Such collaboration activities will also include joint research conferences, visitations and sabbaticals at each other's premises; subject to mutual consent of both the parties. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms and conditions lay down by separate written agreement by both organizations.

2.2 Exchange of academic information, materials and facilities

Both parties agree to exchange academic information, facilities, resources etc. as mutually agreed from time to time.

2.3 Students Exchange

Short Courses/ Summer School: These courses, usually two to four weeks in duration, will normally be held in spring or summer as mutually agreed. The programs will facilitate visits by students and faculty to learn about the industry environment and culture. In addition to various topics on industry operations and culture, the course would include meetings with industry executives, and visits to various industrial establishments. The cost and other terms of such programs will be mutually worked out separately each year.

2.4 Faculty and Staff Exchange

Both organizations agree to develop opportunities for faculty to teach courses, conduct seminars and undertake such other activities at each other's campus as mutually agreed. Visiting faculty will be provided with opportunities to observe and share teaching methods and curriculum. NRIIT and BWEC will exchange faculty according to the terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon.

2.5 Organizing/ participation in Joint symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops etc.

Both organizations will promote their faculty and staff participation in the conferences, conclaves and seminars organized by each other to strengthen the ties between both the organizations and will also jointly organize symposia, seminars, conferences, workshops and other programs as mutually agreed.

3. Advertising & Publicity

Both the parties will publicly advertise the collaboration under this MoU among students, staff etc., if agreed by their management. Where reasonably possible, in

making advertisements or public announcements in relation to this MoU, each organization shall acknowledge the participation of other organization and the contribution that other organization has made if any.

4. Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the both organizations and will remain in effect for one (1) year. This MOU will be renewed upon its expiry, as per mutual agreement of both organizations. If either organization wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of one year period or in between the period of one year, it must notify the other organization not less than one month prior to the expiry of the MOU. The event of termination will not affect participants from completing their activities at the host party already initiated or ongoing unless otherwise mutually agreed. This MoU, its renewal and the actions taken under it will be reviewed at any time. Modifications to MoU will be made by mutual consent and any amendment or extension to the MoU will be formalized by the exchange of letters and or emails between the two organizations.



5. Coordinators:

Each organization agrees to appoint an overall Coordinator for the administration of this MOU. The Coordinator will serve as the contact person on campus. These coordinators will ensure smooth flow of communication and would be responsible to ensure that necessary approvals are in place for student/faculty exchange, articulation agreement etc. These coordinators will be responsible to ensure the effectiveness and enforcement MOU. Both organizations are responsible for keeping their contact details up to date. Contact details and address of the designated coordinators are given here under.

6. Resolution of Disputes and Governing Law:

In the event of any unforeseen issues or matters not covered herein or any controversy, dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this MoU, the same shall be resolved amicably by both the organizations. This MoU and further agreements will in all respect be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Republic of India. This MOU shall be signed in counterpart. Each counterpart will

constitute an original document and these counterparts taken together, shall constitute one and the same MOU.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made on this 29 of January,
Two thousand and twenty one (2021)

BETWEEN

SHRI GOUTAM DAS, Entrepreneur of CSC| e-Governance Services India Limited,
under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (Government of India),
Electronics Niketan, 6, CGO Complex, Lodhi road, Pragati vihar, New Delhi – 100 003,
herein after referred to as the **FIRST PARTY**

AND

THE PRINCIPAL (Dr. Dipak Ranjan Jana), Bapatla Women's Engineering College,
Srinivas nagar, Guntur NH 214A, Bapatla - Ongole road, Bapatla, Andhra Pradesh –
522101, herein after referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**

WHEREAS the first party is Entrepreneur of CSC| e-Governance Services India Limited, under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (Government of India) has developed an extraordinary short term course for the purpose of achieving the fluency in spoken English as an extracurricular educational activity relating to the British Council spoken English course and certification and career and personality development course, amongst the young students to build up an shining career in future and in various spare of life and profession and offered the second party herein to introduce the said course for the students of its college.

AND WHERAS the second party has accepted the offer of the first party for the ultimate benefit of the students and have provided the details of the interested students in the said college.

IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERE TO AS FOLLOWS.

GENERAL:

1. That the first party has offered the course of British Council spoken English course and certification program along with a career and personality development course for the college students. The course synopsis and other details have been depicted in schedule and the course fees have been annexed herewith.
2. That the second party has accepted the offer of the first party herein for the ultimate benefit of the students in the said college to build upon a strong career in future.
3. That second party has shared the details of the interested students such as students data i.e. name, parents name, address, mobile number, email id and aadhar card number, who have registered their names for the said courses offered by the first party and the first party shall provide the login credentials, i.e. login id and password along with the link for downloading and installing the app(s), i.e. English strokes and career strokes after the students registration/ enrollment resources in respect to the project, directly from the students' own devices.

4. That neither party shall held the other liable, if any students does not complete her course and the first party shall not be bound to provide any kind of certificate after completion of courses as the each and every students shall have to download their respective certificates online from the website of the British Council.
5. That it is agreed upon the first party that, if any student faces any sort of difficulty in connection with login id, the first party shall provide alternate login id and after every success login by each student the first party shall have no responsibility in any manner whatsoever.
6. That the second party agrees to provide the following financial resources, i.e. as enrollment fees Rs. 101.00/- (Rupees one hundred and one) only collected directly from the students and shall transfer the same to the given bank account of the first party.
7. The parties acknowledges that no contractual relationship is created between them by this memorandum, but agree to work together in the true spirit of partnership to ensure that there is a united, visible and responsive leadership of the project and to demonstrate financial, administrative and supportive commitment to the project by means of the following educational services.
8. Each party will work together in coordinated fashion for fulfillment of the project.

11. Nothing in this memorandum will obligate any party to the transfer of funds. Any endeavour involving the reimbursement or contribution of funds between the parties of this memorandum will be handled in accordance with the applicable laws, regulations and procedures. Such endeavours will be outlined in separate agreements that shall be made in writing by representatives of the parties involved and shall be independently authorized by the appropriate statutory authority. This memorandum does not provide such authority.
12. This memorandum is not intended to and does not create any right, benefit or trust responsibility.
13. This memorandum will effective upon the signature of both the parties
14. Any party may terminate its participation in this memorandum by providing written notice to the other party.

TERM

15. The memorandum of understanding made by and between the parties shall remain valid from the date of signing till the success login of all the students provided by the second party. The term can be extended only by agreement of all the parties.

NOTICE

16. Any notice or communication required or permitted by this memorandum shall be efficiently given if delivered in person or official mail, return receipt requested, to the address set forth in the description of the parties at the opening paragraphs or to such other address as one party may have furnished to the other in writing and/or available in official record.

GOVERNING LAW

17. The memorandum shall be constructed in accordance with the laws of the union of India.

ASSIGNMENT

18. Neither party may assign or transfer the responsibilities or agreement made here in without the prior written consent of the non-assigning party, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.

AMENDMENT

19. This memorandum may be amended or supplemented in writing, if the writing is signed by the party obligated under this memorandum.

SEVERABILITY

20. If any provision of this memorandum is found to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions will continue to be valid and enforceable. If a court finds that any portion of this memorandum is invalid or unenforceable, but that limiting such provisions it would become valid and enforceable, then such provisions will be deemed to be written, constructed and enforced as so limited.

PRIOR MEMORANDUM SUSPENDED

21. This memorandum constitutes the entire memorandum between the parties relating to this subject matter and supersedes all prior or simultaneous representations, discussions, negotiations and memorandums, whether written or oral.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

22. That if any dispute arises between the parties concerned the same shall be referred to the sole arbitrator appointed by the first party herein, and award issue by the arbitrator will be binding on both the parties in all time the place and venue of the arbitration shall be under the jurisdiction of Bapatla, Andhra Pradesh.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

23. That the second party shall explain the students the following guidelines:

- A. With the username and password given by the VLE, the user will login the given access page from our server, where the user will download the English strokes app and career strokes app.
- B. Once the user downloads and login, for security purpose, users' device information such as IMEI number, model number, serial number, location will be captured and locked to that user to ensure it is only for that particular device. This cannot be transferred to any device or any other user.
- C. It is onetime process.
- D. The student can now access the complete course with same user credentials on mobile, laptops, desktops and tablets.
- E. We will be tracking all the users through tracking system. Don't share the app. For best experience and good results use faster network (4G, Wifi).
- F. For additional clarification and details and second party shall follow the standard operating procedure (SOP) as attached with this MoU.
- G. It is agreed by and between parties that the instant MoU shall remain valid for 6 years from the date of signing, provided that either of the party can suspend the functionality of this MoU, three months prior notice in writing and it is also provided that course fee may vary every year and course fee shall be paid by the part of the second party, i.e. either with the same rate or the enhanced rate as mutually agreed every year.
